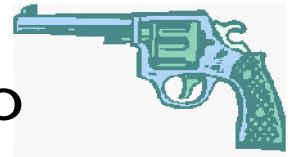

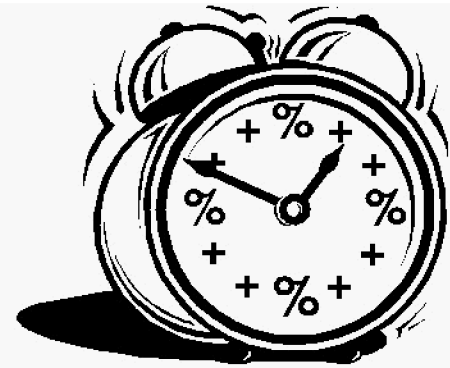

Meeting Highlights:

At the October HRP members meeting, Texas Jack Morales brought up some proposed changes to SASS Rules that will be addressed and voted into the rule book when he goes to the Territorial Governor's meeting at the SASS convention in December. If you would like a full explanation of what is proposed or would like to talk with him concerning these, give him a call. He'll be making decisions that will be representing our club in the best interest and some of the issues will probably be better discussed at the convention after he's heard the various pro's and con's. One change would be concerning Classic Cowboy - it's being proposed that chaps and spurs are required along with 3 other items from the costuming selection. Two of our Classic Cowboy shooters, Zeke and Silver Sage Outlaw recommended that this be approved. Another proposed change would be that Minor Safetys be limited to 4 per stage rather than the unlimited number it is now; after some discussion it was decided that this was one better made after listening to more input since there is an issue of "doublejeopardy". Other changes that were being proposed were decided to be more of an individual ranges requirements rather than SASS rules and would be left to Texas Jack to decide their merit.
